Haverstock Road site, Sandringham

We're building the Central Interceptor, a super-sized wastewater tunnel to reduce overflows, creating a better environment for you to enjoy.

Construction update

Construction at our Haverstock site is more than 80% complete. We still need to finish some minor work on the shaft and newly installed manholes and chambers.

The plant room next to the shaft has been constructed and painted and the internal fit-out is underway. This will be the only permanent structure remaining above ground on site when we've finished our work.

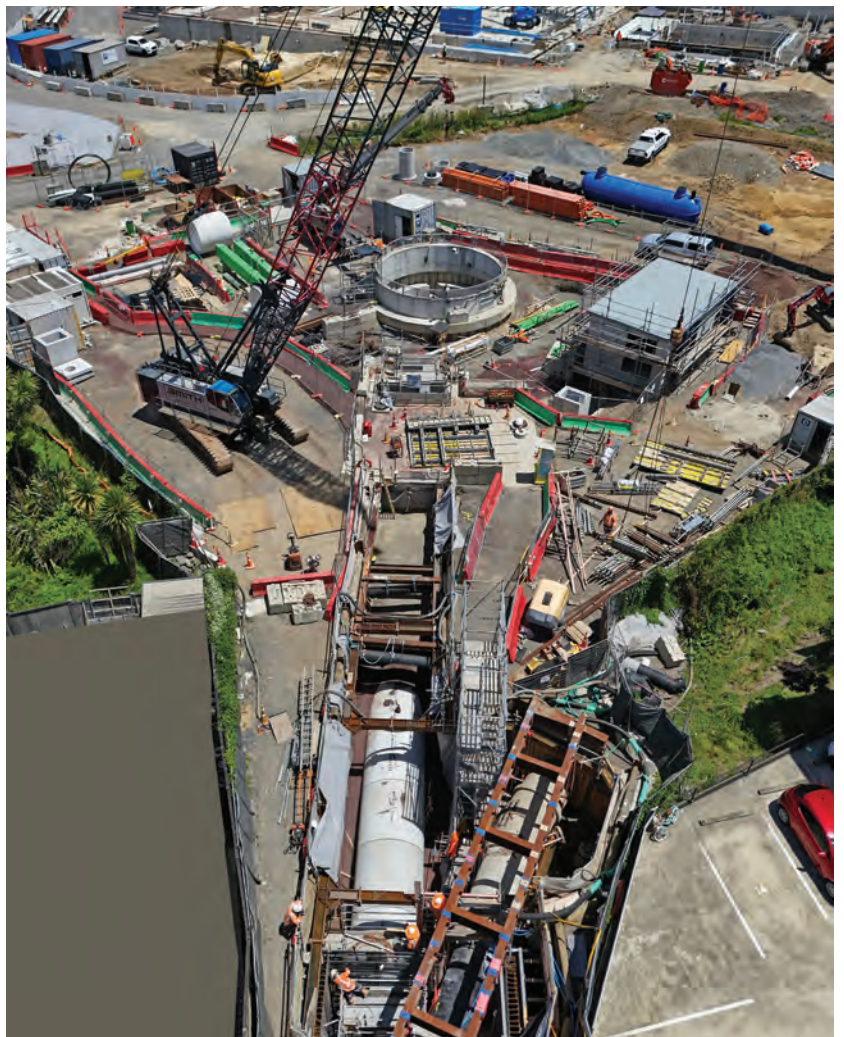
The bulk of the remaining construction is on the new chambers being built in the accessway from Haverstock Road. Pipe installation from the new control chamber we have built to the access road chamber is ongoing. Work is expected to be completed by June 2026.

Our site footprint has shrunk to accommodate the ongoing construction at Plant and Food next door. Camden Road continues to be the exit for construction traffic from both our sites.

What's next?

Completing the new chambers and manholes is our primary focus while we work on finishing minor work on the other new infrastructure already built. When construction has been completed, we will be carrying out final connections and testing to make sure everything is working for the Central Interceptor tunnel to be operational in mid-2026.

There will be minimal reinstatement needed on this site once construction and testing are complete. Trafficable access will be installed in the accessway from Haverstock and the area containing the plant room will be fenced off to secure the Watercare land. The rest of the site will be handed back to Plant and Food.
